



## DOGBONE DAMPER

Be sure to read and completely understand this procedure before applying product. Be sure to select the proper PREFORMED™ product before application.



Step #1 Open the bolt and keeper so as to accomodate the diameter of the conductor. Place onto the conductor to check for proper fit.

Based on the damper placement recommendation, the damper may be placed over the Armor Rods, over AGS rods, or placed on bare conductor.




Step #2 Using the placement recommendations provided by PLP or the Placement Software, measure the appropriate distance from the suspension's center line or the end of the dead end clamp itself. A damper placement chart is provided on the back of these instructions.



Step #3 Center the damper at the proper distance (a tolerance of 2 inches is allowed) and tighten the bolt according to the torque recommendations provided on the back of these instructions. Note: If shear head bolts have been provided, just tighten until the bolt head shears off.




**Step #4** Completed installation.


